## Mr. Keith Dickey

At Oak Grove High School, Mr. Keith Dickey achieved a 4.0 GPA, graduated as salutatorian of his class, earned several athletic accolades, including four individual state wrestling titles, and participated in Student Council as the senior class president, National Honor Society, and DECA. Mr. Dickey earned four varsity letters in football and earned recognition on the All Conference and All District teams. In wrestling, he earned individual state titles at 103, 112, 125, and 130.
