- ✓ Ask about academic requirements and offerings
- ✓ If possible attend a class to get an idea of typical size, teaching style, academic atmosphere
- ✓ Ask about placement record for graduates in your field of study
- ✓ Identify career planning services for undergraduates
- ✓ Tour the campus. Check out residence halls, dining options, library resources etc.
- ✓ Talk to students about general academic environment, etc.
- ✓ Find out what student activities are available and about campus social life and social activities.
